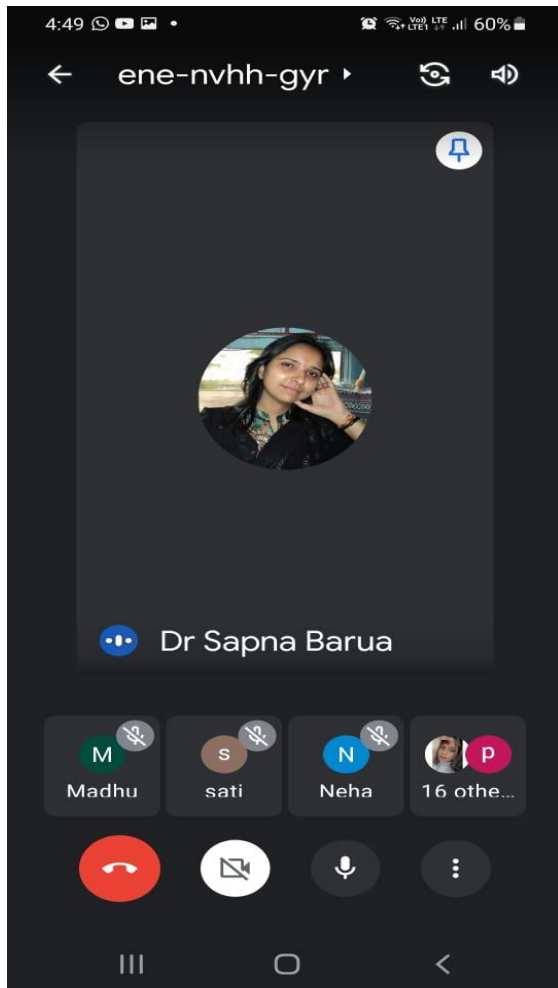
Outcome:
