Report on World Environment Day Celebration 2020

Introduction:

To commemorate **World Environment Day** on **5th June 2020**, **Sri Arvind Mahila College** organized an online event under the guidance of **Dr. Prem Kumari**, Nodal Officer EBSB, and **Dr. Rita Singh** and **Dr. Geeta Kumari**, NSS Program Officers. The event focused on raising awareness about environmental changes brought on by the **COVID-19 lockdown**.

In line with the theme of the day, an online **poetry competition** titled “**Lockdown Due to Coronavirus: Environmental Changes**” was organized, where students could present their self-composed poems either through a **recorded voice message** or **live performance**. This creative initiative aimed to highlight the positive and negative environmental changes observed during the lockdown and how nature had been impacted during this period of social isolation.

Objectives:

1. To raise awareness about the changes in the environment due to the **COVID-19 lockdown**.
2. To encourage students to express their thoughts and reflections on the impact of the pandemic on nature and the environment through creative means like poetry.
3. To provide a platform for students to showcase their creativity while contributing to the global conversation on environmental conservation.

- **Format:** Online Poetry Presentation (Self-composed Poems in Hindi and English)
- **Participants:** 23 students from Sri Arvind Mahila College
- **Languages:** 19 students presented their poems in **Hindi**, and 4 students presented in **English**.

Program Highlights:

Poetry Presentations:

The event was inaugurated with a brief introduction about the importance of World Environment Day and the impact of the pandemic on the environment. The students presented their **self-composed poems** through **voice recordings**, highlighting various environmental changes noticed during the lockdown, such as the improvement in air quality, reduced pollution, and the resurgence of wildlife in urban spaces.

Judging Process:

The poems were judged based on creativity, relevance to the theme, and the emotional and environmental message conveyed. The judging panel consisted of three esteemed faculty members:

- **Dr. Prabha Mishra**, an expert in environmental studies
- **Dr. Sarita Kumari**, a senior faculty member
- **Dr. Norah Nivedita Shah**, an expert in English literature who evaluated the English-language poems.

Participation:

A total of **22 students** participated in the competition, with **19 poems in Hindi** and **4 poems in English**. The students expressed their personal observations and reflections on how the **COVID-19 lockdown** gave the environment a chance to heal, focusing on topics such as **reduced vehicular pollution, clear skies, improved water quality**, and the positive impact on wildlife.

Conclusion:

The **online poetry competition** held on **World Environment Day 2020** was an inspiring and insightful event. It encouraged students to reflect on the environmental changes brought about by the global pandemic and express their thoughts creatively. The event also served as a reminder of the urgent need for environmental conservation and the potential for positive change when human activities are reduced.

The participation of 22 students and the active involvement of the judging panel made the event a success. The creative contributions of the students helped highlight the importance of **environmental awareness** and **sustainable living**.
